QUEENSLAND CATASTROPHIC BURIAL FOR SURE as a six metre long (20ft), and fully intact Elasmosaurus was found in western Queensland. Elasmosaurus has a Plesiosaur like body and is an extinct aquatic reptile with up to 72 bones in its a very long neck. Since you can't slowly bury a decomposing six metre (20ft) long creature with its head still attached to such a skinny elongate neck protruding from a short fat body with squat limbs and tail, the burial was provably rapid and so such covering was either the cause of death or occurred shortly after death. 



Climate Change Brings Brolar Bears

NOW AN EVIDENCE UPDATE FROM DIANE EAGER

CLIMATE CHANGE BRINGS BROLAR BEARS as Arctic regions in North America and Russia are warming, brown bears are moving north so they cross paths with polar bears more often. Brown and polar bears can cross breed and produce fertile offspring, now named a "brolar" bear. These hybrids bears are becoming more common and the hybrids are also breeding with brown bears. Scientists are now concerned that polar bears will become extinct from both hybridising and from climate change. Brown bears are considered more adaptable than polar bears as brown bears have a more varied diet. According to an article in Science Alert, "Unlike polar bears which mostly feed on blubber and meat, brown have a super varied diet. They will eat, grass, veg and berries and just about anything they can get their paws on, which means these are likely to better cope with any environmental changes in the future." The article goes on: "Polar bears are not nearly so adaptable, but perhaps new genes from brown bears could help the species survive in the Arctic. If that's the case, polar bears may still exist in the decades to come, but they'll never be quite the same as before. One day, they could even represent an entirely new species."

ED. COM. The people who live with polar bears will tell you that polar bears will also eat whatever they can get their paws onto, and a visit to any Zoo in the west will tell you the same. (Check out the Polar Bear pages on Sea World, Queensland, Australia) Nevertheless, a bit of gene mixing may be good for both species, to help them survive and adapt. Note, however, the adaptation that is referred to here is NOT evolution. It is simply the ability to cope with a changes in the environment, but it cannot change the bears into any new kind of animal.

Brown/polar bear hybrids are sometimes called "grolar bears" after the grizzly bear, which is a type of brown bear. Whatever they are named, even if they are classified as a new species they will not have evolved. They are still bears. The fact that polar bears and brown bears can mate and produce fertile offspring indicates they are both part of the one bear kind. The brolar bears have been proven to be able to still mate with brown bears and produce offspring, so classifying them as a new species serves only as a reminder that the classification system is simply a means of organising our knowledge of the living world, and does NOT represent evolution. Even if the distinctive white furred polar bears disappear, their mutant colour loss genes will still be in the bear population, so they could be bred back if anyone wanted to do that. Environmentalists should stop worrying, and let bears do their own thing and practice survival of the fittest, which is a real process but it never makes anything do Darwinian evolution.



OLDEST FOSSIL BRAIN An international team of scientists have studied a fossil Lobopodian, a small extinct arthropod with a segmented trunk and multiple short stubby legs. The fossil has been named *Cardiodictyon catenulum* and is dated as 525 million years old. Using sophisticated scanning techniques researchers were able to identify the creature's brain. Nicholas Strausfeld of University of Arizona, who led the study commented: "To our knowledge, this is the oldest fossilized brain we know of, so far." The brain had three sections, two associated with head appendages and one associated with the

front end of its digestive system. The researchers compared the brain with living and fossil arthropods and they also studied patterns of gene expression for forming brains in living arthropods. According to University of Arizona News the researchers concluded "a shared blueprint of brain organization has been maintained from the Cambrian until today." Franks Hirth of Kings College London, one of the researchers, explained: "By comparing known gene expression patterns in living species we identified a common signature of all brains and how they are formed." He went on to say: "We realized that each brain domain and its corresponding features are specified by the same combination of genes, irrespective of the species we looked at. This suggested a common genetic ground plan for making a brain."

If this is the oldest known fossil brain and so similar to present day arthropods it is evidence that arthropod brains have always been brains, and have functioned as such right from the start. Notice the references to processes that involved forward planning – blueprint, genetic ground plan. It is not just enough to have the genes for a brain – it also takes the right gene expression, i.e. which genes are turned on and off, and for how long, and most importantly, which combination of genes must be turned on together. Even though the standard story is that brains evolved by chance random mutations, the actual research shows that forming a brain takes plan and purpose. Genes themselves are information, but there is further layer of information involved in organising genes before a useful structure like a brain, even a simple one possessed by this small invertebrate, can be formed and function in association with other parts of the animal's body.

This study of fossil and living arthropod brains reveals exactly what you would expect from reading Genesis, which tells us that God made whole fully functioning organisms right from the start, and they have reproduced after their kind with the fully functioning brains ever since, although some, like this lobopodian, have died out.
