

Preparations to implement WHO's Pandemic Treaty march forward as World Bank creates the largest fund ever for global pandemics

The following is an adaptation of James Roguski's article 'Pandemic Treaty Update' published on 26 November 2022.

INB will be meeting for the third time on Monday, Tuesday and Wednesday, 5-7 December 2022. It is unclear as to whether or not they will be live-streaming their meetings.

On 25 November 2022, the INB published the seven (7) documents listed below on their nearly invisible web page:

1. Provisional agenda
2. Draft programme of work
3. Conceptual zero draft for the consideration of the Intergovernmental Negotiating Body at its third meeting *
4. Proposal by the Bureau on an updated timeline and deliverables, development of the zero draft of the WHO CA+, and establishment of drafting group modalities
5. Summaries of regional committee discussions on the working draft Report by the Secretariat
6. Informal, focused consultations Report by the Bureau of the Intergovernmental Negotiating Body
7. Outcomes of the second round of public hearings Report by the Secretariat

Of the seven documents, the most important is the official version of the “Conceptual Zero Draft” of the proposed “Pandemic Treaty.”

Note: James Roguski obtained and published an advance copy of this draft. “I believe that the official copy is the same as the advance copy,” he wrote. You can read his article and a copy of the draft [HERE](#). At the [end of his latest article](#), Roguski gave a five-minute audio summary of the draft document and the Pandemic Treaty which has been renamed in the draft as “WHO CA+.” The draft doesn’t define the acronym, but Roguski has guessed it most likely is an abbreviation for “World Health Organisation Convention Agreement and more” – WHO CA+

The above schedule is regarding the proposed Pandemic Treaty.

The schedule in the table below is regarding the proposed amendments to the International Health Regulations.

November 28 – December 2, 2022: (IHRRC) A face-to-face meeting (5 days, Geneva, Switzerland) for report drafting purposes, with, at least, one day meeting with Member States, United Nations and its specialised agencies and other relevant intergovernmental organisations or nongovernmental organisations in official relations with WHO, the Bureau of the Intergovernmental Negotiating Body (INB), and the WGIHR;

December 15-16, 2022: (IHRRC) Closed virtual working meeting;

January 9-13, 2023: (IHRRC) A face-to-face meeting (5 days, Geneva, Switzerland) for finalization of the report, with, at least, one-day meeting with Member States, the United Nations and its specialized agencies and other relevant intergovernmental organizations or nongovernmental organizations in official relations with WHO, the Bureau of the INB, and the WGIHR.

January 15, 2023 WGIHR is scheduled to submit amendments to the Director General of the WHO.

May 2023 The WHO consistently claims that their goal is to consider these amendments at the 77th World Health Assembly in May 2024, but the amendments COULD be voted on by the 76th World Health Assembly in May 2023.
