The Darlington Nurses' hearing continued for a third week, as they fight for what should be their obvious and basic right to women's only spaces.

Our legal team continue to support the nurses in court, and there were several more updates from court:

- <u>'Rose' gave evidence</u> the transgender, biological male who uses the nurses' changing room and asked a nurse when she was going to change.
- It was uncovered that a NHS executive retired after raising concerns about the Trust's policy on allowing men to change in women's spaces.
- Testimony revealed that the <u>Director of HR at the NHS Trust told the nurses to 'broaden their mindset'</u> and accept that the man could use their changing room.
- Evidence also revealed that the NHS pressured the nurses to drop their concerns.

Media interest continued to report on the case as well:
