


Hosts Lavish 5th Annual Ramadan Iftar on Blood-Soaked Ground (Video)

In a display of cowardice and amnesia, the U.S. Army at Fort Hood, Texas – the very site where Muslim Major Nidal Hasan screamed “Allahu Akbar” as he gunned down 13 innocent soldiers and wounded 32 more in 2009 – is now rolling out the red carpet for a lavish “5th Annual Ramadan Iftar” dinner. Hosted by the base’s Muslim community at the Main Post Chapel, this event spits directly on the graves of our fallen heroes.

No Islamic nation on Earth would ever dream of hosting an Easter egg hunt for Christians or a Passover seder for Jews. Yet here we are, in the land of the free, bending over backward to celebrate Ramadan on the blood-soaked ground of Fort Hood. Christians get a token egg hunt at best, while Muslims are treated to special programs and dinners. Why the double standard? Why are we allowing this infiltration into our military – the backbone of our defense – when history screams warnings at us?

The original alert came from Valentina Gomez, who [exposed](#) this outrage: “The @USArmy at @forthoodarmy celebrates muslims during Ramadan with a nice Program & Dinner. Christians don’t get celebrated; they just get a little egg hunt. Fort Hood forgot that a muslim officer murdered 13 & injured 32 others in ‘09. Muslims do not belong in our military. Their allegiance is to the quran & it tells them to kill every infidel. I wonder how many people have to get allahu akbar’ed before Texans wake up.”



She is absolutely right. It's backed by facts and ignored prophecies from brave voices like Tennessee State Representative Rick Womick. Back in 2011, at a Tennessee Freedom Coalition event, Womick laid it all out, warning that devout Muslims in the U.S. military pose a grave danger because their loyalty to Sharia (Islamic law) directly conflicts with our Constitution. But his colleagues abandoned him, too spineless to stand up.

In a powerful interview that's more relevant today than ever, Womick explained:

“Let's go a step further... this is from the Department of Justice. The Department of Justice has put out statistics on terrorist acts from Civil War to 2000... In 2000-2010, there were 323 acts of domestic terrorism, of which 290 were committed by Islamic terrorists – over 85% of acts of terrorism in this country are now caused by Islamists. Before 2000, they really didn't exist – 1 or 2 percent. Why such an increase in Islamic terrorism since 2000?”



Womick hammered home the truth about Islam: “So yes, personally, I don't trust one Muslim in our military... Because they're commanded to lie... And if they truly are a devout Muslim and follow the Quran, then I feel threatened because they're commanded to kill me.”

Through the Islamic doctrine of taqiyya – the commandment to lie and deceive to advance Islam – and the Quran's explicit calls to kill infidels, the threat is built in. Womick cited DOJ stats showing that from 2000-2010, over 85% of domestic terror acts were by Islamic terrorists,

a massive spike from virtually nothing before. And yet, our leaders ignored him. Now, in 2026, we're seeing the consequences: Ramadan celebrations at Fort Hood, where Hasan's jihadist rampage still echoes.

Our military should be a fortress of loyalty to the Constitution, not a breeding ground for divided allegiances. Devout Muslims swear fealty to the Quran first – a book that commands violence against non-believers – not to our flag. Islam isn't just a religion; it's a complete political, legal, financial, and ideological system incompatible with American values.

It's time to heed Womick's warning, ban Sharia-compliant accommodations in our military, and put America first. Our heroes deserve better than this betrayal.
